

The 2019 Chef Curtis Duffy Scholarship

Contest Rules

Auguste Escoffier School of Culinary Arts presents the 2019 Chef Curtis Duffy Scholarship Competition! Contestants will have the opportunity to compete for **8** scholarships totaling \$14,000.

Scholarship Competition Details:

This contest is open to 2019 high school graduates who are interested in attending Auguste Escoffier School of Culinary Arts in Austin or Boulder (residential programs only).

Scholarships will be distributed as follows:

• Austin Campus:

\$2,500 (two winners will be selected)
\$1,000 (two winners will be selected)

• Boulder Campus:

\$2,500 (two winners will be selected)
\$1,000 (two winners will be selected)

Eligibility:

- 1. **Austin Campus:** Must be a 2019 high school graduate enrolled in one of our Fall 2019 starts.
- 2. **Boulder Campus**: Must be a 2019 high school graduate enrolled in one of our Fall 2019 starts.

Scholarship Submission Content / Materials:

The 2019 Chef Curtis Duffy Scholarship Competition requires participants to create a video or written essay answering the following question.

1. What or who has inspired you to become a chef?

Submission Instructions:

To enter, fill out our entry form online:

- 1. **Step 1:** Decide if you would like to submit your answer in video or essay form.
 - a. Option 1: Video submission: Each contestant must upload his or her video to YouTube to create a video link. Then include your YouTube link on your entry form. <u>Submit here</u>.
 - b. Option 2: Essay submission: Each contestant must write a 250 word (or longer) double spaced essay. Upload your word document to the entry form. <u>Submit here</u>.
- 2. By submitting your video or essay, each contestant agrees to the competition rules and concurs to be bound by the final decisions of the judges.
- 3. Deadline for entry is Monday, April 15, 2019.

Video Judging:

A committee, including Curtis Duffy, will evaluate qualifying entries.

Scholarship Winners:

All scholarship winners will be announced by Monday, April 22, 2019. Scholarship winners will be notified by telephone. If the contestant is not available by telephone, Auguste Escoffier School of Culinary Arts will attempt to reach him or her by email.

Rights in Submissions:

By entering a video or essay in the Chef Curtis Duffy Scholarship Competition, each entrant hereby grants to Auguste Escoffier School of Culinary Arts or its

designee a license to use or publish without any further right of approval by or compensation to the entrant. Winners may be required to share progress during and after their education with Auguste Escoffier School of Culinary Arts on how the scholarship affected their path.

*Scholarships are applied to a student's account over the course of a student's time in school.
